The LEED for Homes Green Building Rating System is a consensus based tool developed by the U.S. Green Building Council that verifies the durability, sustainability and performance of homes. It is a nationally accepted benchmark for the design, construction, and operation of high performance green homes. With lower energy and water bills, reduced greenhouse gas emissions, and fewer problems with mold, mildew and other indoor toxins, LEED Homes are safer, healthier, more comfortable and more durable.

In order to achieve the LEED for Homes Gold certification, this home will be Energy Star Certified and include the following: Geothermal Heating & Cooling System; Icynene Spray Foam Insulation; Water Conservation System; Energy Efficient Features; Indoor Air Quality Features; Recycled Building Materials; Energy Star Rated Appliances, Windows, Lighting & Plumbing Fixtures.

This home will also be featured as a *Southern Living* Dream Home, as LandMark Resources was recently selected as the exclusive *Southern Living* Custom Builder Program member in OK. Each year, *Southern Living* carefully selects members based on their reputation among local business and consumers; strength of presence in their respective markets; superior quality and attention to detail; innovative style; and other criteria.
